

Notice of Medicare Non-Coverage (NOMNC)

- Is the NOMNC required when Medicare covered Part B therapy services are ending for a beneficiary residing in a SNF?

Yes, the NOMNC is required for all beneficiaries residing in a Skilled Nursing Facility (SNF), not under Part A, when all, or the last, Medicare covered Part B therapy services (PT, OT, and Speech) are ending.

- Should we give the NOMNC when a beneficiary is discharging to hospice from a Medicare covered SNF stay or from Medicare covered home health services?

No, you should not give the NOMNC when a beneficiary elects the hospice benefit.

- May we deliver and maintain the NOMNC electronically?

Yes, you may deliver and electronically maintain the NOMNC. If a provider elects to deliver a NOMNC viewed on an electronic screen before signing, the beneficiary must be given the option of requesting paper delivery over electronic delivery if that is what the beneficiary prefers. Regardless of whether a paper or electronic version is delivered and regardless of whether the signature is digitally captured or manually penned, the beneficiary must be given a paper copy of the NOMNC with the required beneficiary specific information inserted, at the time of notice delivery.

- Should we give the NOMNC when the 100-day SNF benefit has exhausted?

No, you should not give the NOMNC when the 100-day SNF benefit has exhausted.

- Is the NOMNC required when Medicare covered care is ending for beneficiaries in Swing Beds?

Yes, the NOMNC is required for beneficiaries in hospital swing beds if their Medicare covered SNF care is ending.

- Are providers required to deliver the NOMNC to Medicare Advantage enrollees?

Yes, providers must deliver the NOMNC to beneficiaries in Original Medicare (fee-for-service) and Medicare Advantage enrollees, in accordance with CMS guidance.
